#### **Students' feedback**

This year under the Covid19 pandemic situation, the feedback of this session is collected entirely via online through a feedback portal generated by the institution in the college website. Students of final semester provided feedbacks on the institutional curriculum, classes, and on the general conduct of college-administration through a Google Form generated in the Feedback Portal of the college website. These feedbacks are then analyzed by members of the college administration along with a body of non-teaching and teaching staff. Analyses showed that 86% of the 744 students belonging to the Honours batch of final semester could attend the online class while 5% of them could not attend the class for financial reasons, 6% of them did not have internet connection and 3% did not have a mobile. This analysis shows that the college's drive to reach out to maximum number of students through online mode became successful. Near about 55% of the students are happy with the way syllabus was covered in the online classes. Almost 55% of the students say that they are inspired by their teachers regarding consultation of study materials, reference-books and latest research articles on the texts and topics of their respective disciplines. However, owing to the Covid19 condition participation of the students in co-curricular activities dropped down to 52%. Students of each discipline were satisfied the way faculties communicated with them. About 68% of the students welcomed the institution's student-teacher relationship with a positive note and 59% students felt that they could easily share their personal or academic discomforts with their teachers. 60% of the students are satisfied with the way college administrative office works. 57% of the students are happy with the overall performance of the teachers and they missed their institution very much.

## **Teachers' feedback**

In the year of 2020-21 teacher feedback were collected through online mode with 10 different questions and their responses were yes-no type, MCQ type and also short answer type. In the first question- Did you finish your syllabus in time and result shows that 100% of teachers completed their syllabus in time. Hundred percent of the teachers also responded that they helped their students outside the classroom frequently. During the year 41.5 percent teacher publish their research paper in different journals and in different edited books. Most of the teacher said that more than 80 percent student regular in the class during their teaching in the classroom. In the case of teacher-student relationship most of the teacher going through the option with very good but some of them choose satisfactory whether it is in the matter of whole college or in the department. Teacher statement about the library facilities shows a mixed result, where 70 percent of teacher replied with very well except of them replied satisfactory. About the opinion related to administrative activity and staffs of the office 85 percent of the teacher chose the first option that is very good and 15 percent teacher choose the second option and that is satisfactory. In the matter of relationship among faculty of the college, result shows between very good and satisfactory. Only few teachers (18%) said that they have satisfactory type relationship with their colleague but a large number of teachers (82%) have very good relationship with their colleagues. In the question of how did you help in the administrative work during the academic year? Result shows different types of answers by different teachers. Some of them said that actively participated in many administrative works like organizing a Departmental Webinar, participated in NSS Work etc. others said that Documents Collection for NAAC, Plantation in College Campus, Communication with S.D.O For College Environment Develop purpose. Some of the teachers also said that they helped the administration in admission process and examination purpose with their best level.
